

Church Hall Report for Annual General Meeting 2018



The hall continues to be used regularly by both church groups and outside lets. One keep fit group no longer meets due to a drop in numbers, and one organisation has temporarily left as their own outside funding is not available, but they hope to return.

A new cooker has been installed. Some inside lighting has had bulbs changed to LED to hopefully make savings in the long term. Work has begun to improve the outside lighting and this should be completed in the

new year with an extra flood light on the north side of the building, for which a contribution to the cost was made by the social club.

All relevant tests and inspections were carried out with no major work being necessary as a result.

Cleaning has again been carried out by volunteers, with Jean and Dave Pigalles again supporting the hall with more than they are contracted to do, for which we remain extremely grateful. We still need to be aware of the fact that voluntary help is only allowing the hall to tick over and other means of cleaning may have to be looked at in the near future. However, this raises cost implications and at the moment the hall finances are not healthy enough to support this.

The outside area has also been maintained by volunteers.
