Youth Group continues to be well attended with an average of 45 young people attending our monthly meeting in the Church Hall. We meet on the 1st Sunday of the month (except August) between 6:30pm and 8:30pm.

We continue to have lots of varied activities to cater for all tastes.

Football, Dodgeball, Hockey, Table Tennis, Pool, Air Hockey and Table Football, and lots of crafty things to make and take home. The food table is always popular with both members and leaders.
